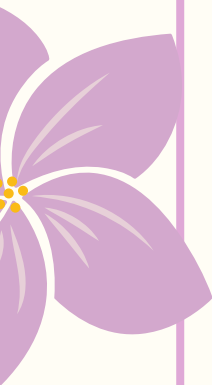

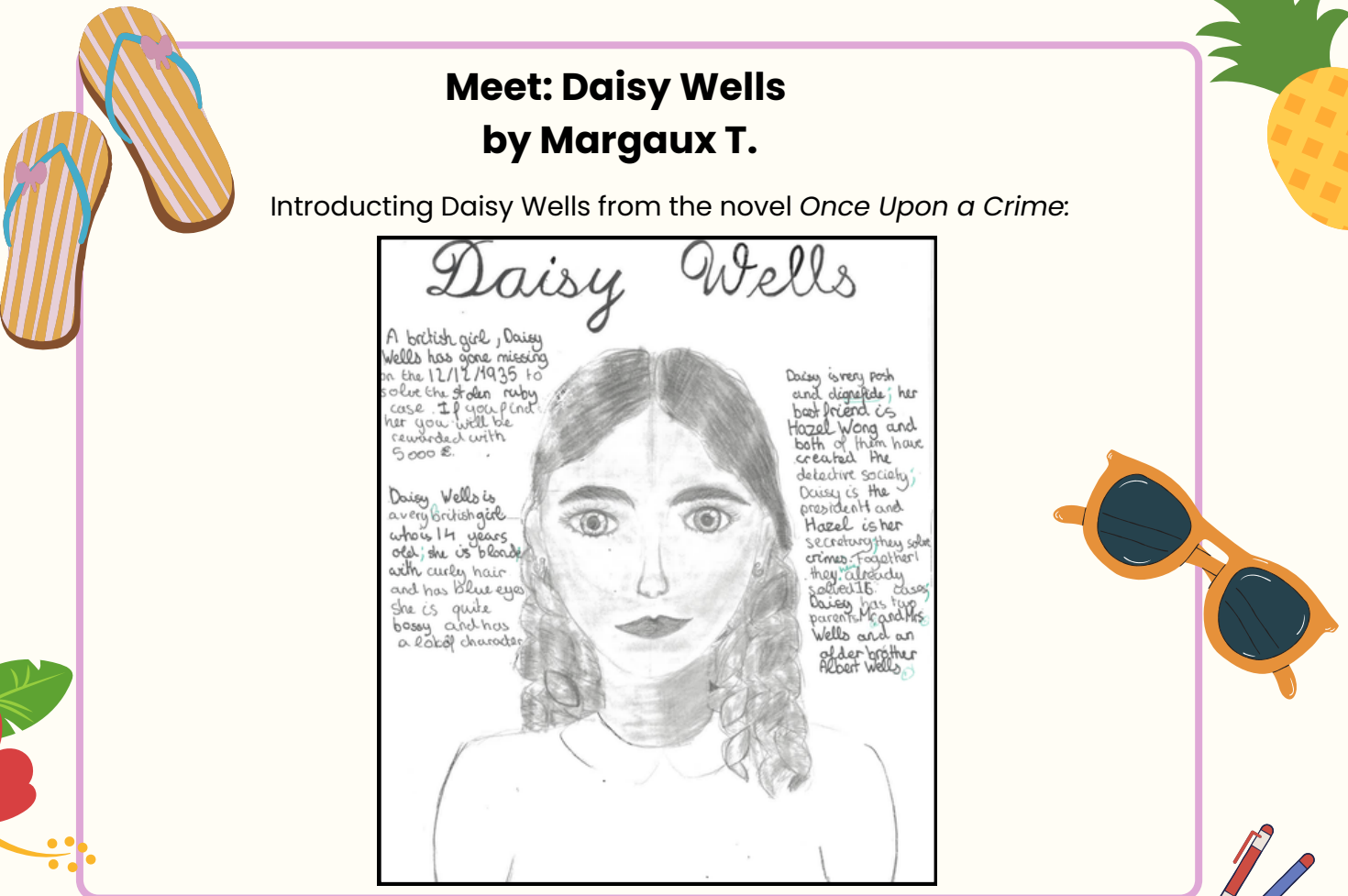


Poem: Summer by Maria-anastasia M.

A turtle in the sea

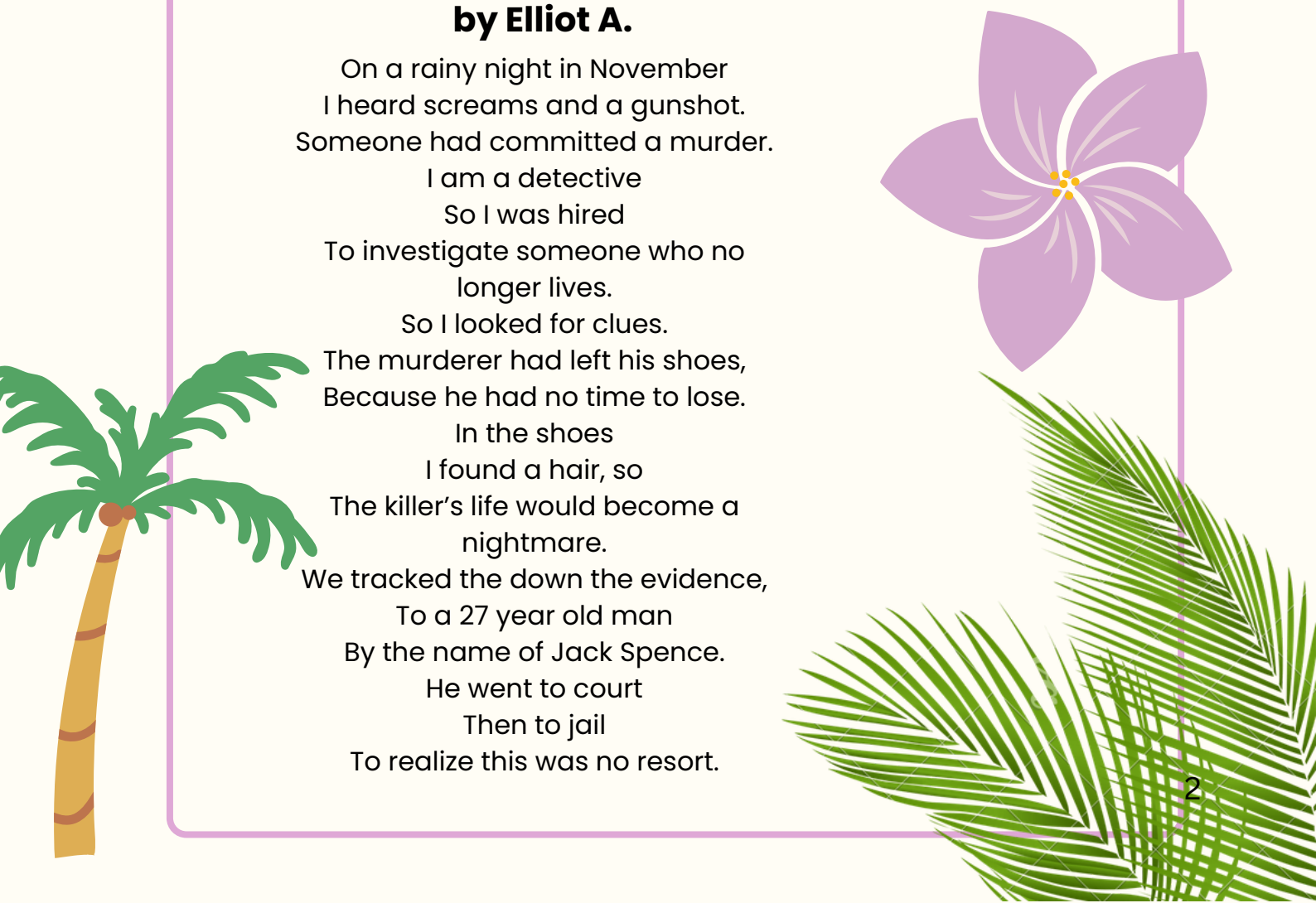
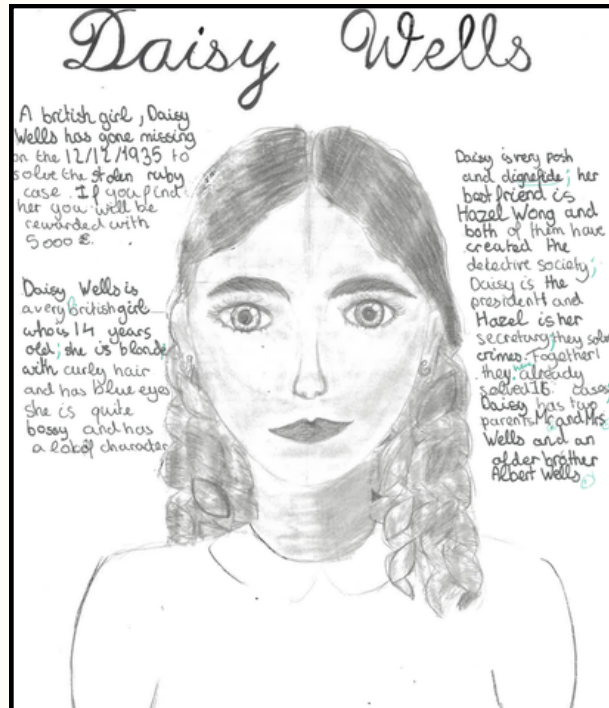
Acting like a bee

Poem: Once Upon a Far, Far, Future Time Away by Valentine L.

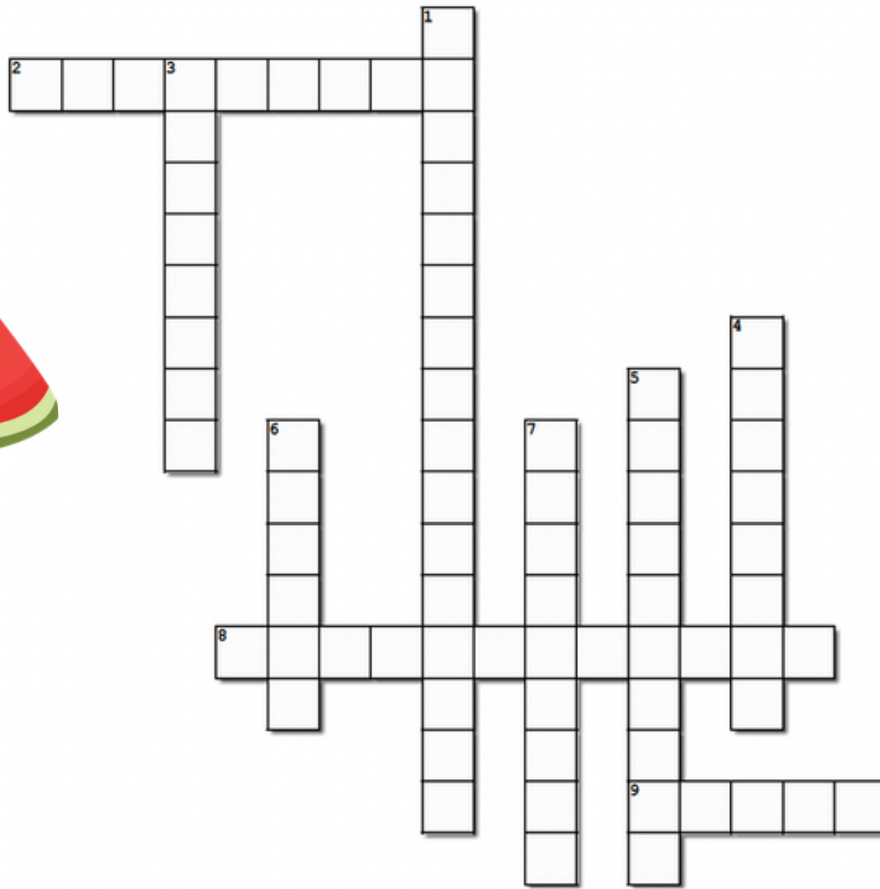
Once upon a time in outer space,
